HOMWORK POLICY

KINDERGARTEN

10 minutes at least three nights a week. Learn poems, rhymes and stories.

FIRST & SECOND GRADE

15 minutes four nights a week on reading skills, flash cards, spelling and/or math.

THIRD GRADE

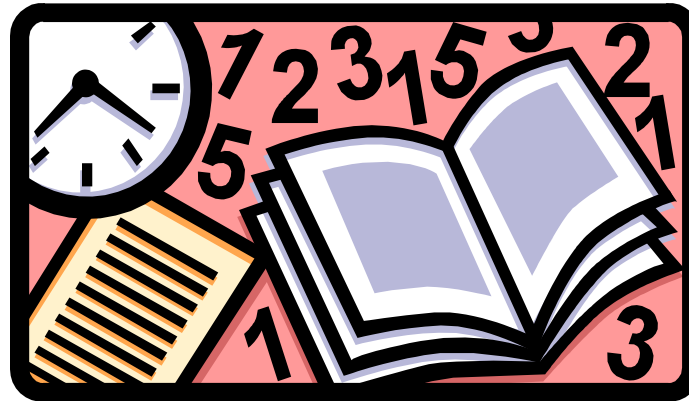
30 minutes four nights a week on reading skills, spelling, math, etc.

FOURTH & FIFTH GRADE

30-40 minutes four nights a week in the areas being studied in class.

SIXTH- EIGHTH GRADE

1 or more hours a night in areas being studied in class(es) ... or if work is done in study hall/class... free reading in topic of interest, and/or practice study and test taking skills.



REQUESTS FOR HOMEWORK

Students who are absent have the responsibility for getting and finishing homework.

If a student is ill three or more days, call the school office to arrange for homework.

Allow at least 24 hours for homework requests to be filled.

Note: The decision on whether or not students receive credit for homework is at discretion of teacher.

4 TIPS FOR HOMEWORK SUCCESS

1. Provide a **WELL LIT** and **QUIET PLACE** for homework to be done.
2. Set a **DESIGNATED TIME** for homework to be done.
3. **DISCUSS** homework and **CHECK FOR ACCURACY**.
4. All homework needs to **BE TURNED IN ON TIME**
