PARENT INVOLVEMENT

Parents are important partners in the education of the Winton School District Students. As part of the partnership parents can become involved through various ways including but not limited to the methods listed on this page.

1. VISITING/VOLUNTEERING IN THE SCHOOL OR CLASSROOM

Parents are welcome to share their special talents and time through Volunteering in the classroom or elsewhere in the school. Contact your school office to learn of opportunities for volunteering. Please remember that visitors must register at the office. School age relatives or friends from other schools are not permitted to visit on campus or accompany and students to class or to other school activities

2. SITE COUNCIL

The school site council is elected and meets each month as an advisory council. Parent orientations, Conferences and other meetings occur through the year.

3. SITE ENGLISH LEARNER ADVISORY COUNCIL (SELAC)

Council of parents who meet to advise on the school English Learner programs and coordinate with the District English Learner Advisory Council (DELAC).

4. DISTRICT ENGLISH LEARNER ADVISORY COUNCIL (DELAC)

Council of parents who meet once a month to advise on the English Learner programs, Master Plan and sign off on mandated Legal documents.

5. PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES

Conferences are arranged during the first three months of the school year. Additional conferences with teachers may be arranged with the teacher on an individual parent-teacher basis. Teachers cannot be expected to have conferences during instructional time.
