Frank Sparkes staff cares about each and every student. Every effort will be given to provide the best opportunity for academic and social success for your child.

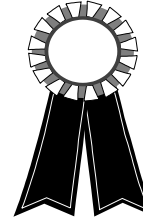
Students will be encouraged to be independent thinkers, and taught skills to help resolve their problems.

SUPER CITIZENS AWARDS



ALL Sparkes students are considered Super Citizens until they forfeit that right. Each month every student starts with a clean record.

Responsibility is important every day in every area of our lives. Sparkes staff members model and monitor responsibility daily. Super Citizens awards are given monthly. You will be formally invited to join in celebrating your child's first award. You are welcome at any time.

STAR STUDENTS are students who choose to do the following:

1. Follow all school rules
 - * in the classroom * on the bus
 - * in the cafeteria * on the playground
 - * walking to and from school
2. Return completed homework, and do the best work possible
3. Maintain good attendance
 - * no unexcused tardies or absences
 - * arrange to make up homework prior to a planned absence
4. Are caring, courteous, kind and respectful to others

Students who are to be recognized receive a Frank Sparkes SUPER CITIZENS. Students who are recognized more than one time will receive additional awards.

Every month each student starts over with a clean record.
